- > Attend the Fall Confirmation RETREAT September 28-29 at Outlaw Ranch
- [Students unable to attend will be required to do an alternative retreat assignment due end of Dec]
- > Complete 10 Worship Notes [Blank forms available at the back of the sanctuary]
- > SERVE COMMUNION 2 Wednesdays with my Small Group at Worship OR COLLECT OFFERING/USHER 2 Wednesdays with my Small Group at Worship
- > HELP with 1 Wednesday DINNER with my Small Group at Calvary [serving or clean-up]
- > Read through Confirmation Handbook with parents
- Each Small Group will come up with its own Mission/Community Service Project
- > 7th GRADE only: Small Group Faith Project
- > 8th GRADE only: Individual Faith Statement

ATTENDANCE: I will participate in Wednesday night confirmation activities: Worship service attendance; Qutreach: group community service; Learning: Pastor-led large group teaching followed by small group discussions; Fellowship. Large & small group events. If I miss class, I will inform my adult leader so I can receive any missed lessons.

**RESPECT:** I will abide by the confirmation handbook and be respectful to all. We will address disagreements in a biblical manner and avoid gossip or slander.
